About the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program

Screening to detect early signs of bowel cancer saves lives. The program offers a free, simple test that can be completed at home.

Why screen?

- Bowel cancer is the second most common cause of cancer death.
- Screening is the only way to detect bowel cancer in its early stages before symptoms appear.

**If found early,
over 90% of bowel
cancers can be
successfully treated**
